Curbing the leverage limits from 100:1 to 10:1 would dampen the interest of retail inestor's interest in forex transactions. Decreasing the leverage to reatil investors would not reduce the probelm of risk. The participating mediataries should play a proactive role in educating the risk potential involved in the trasactions. The mediataries coomercialisation in sharing the research related information with retail customers is one of the cause for maxmising the risk of retail investors. Inestors acting without information is the main causes for loss in forex transactions. Unexpected changes in the trend is the prime cause for losses, reduction in leverage would increase the potential for losses.
