I'm aware that not all brokers offer mini lot services so education to the public would be more usefull than restrictions that cover even those who are informed and have a diciplined approach.

I'm sure you are also aware that restricting the whole community of U.S. traders to unwarrented rules will only drive accounts to less reputable brokers working outside those restrictions; allowing more manipulation of, and dire consequences for the individuals trading their own account.
